



Schedule of Destination Points and Traffic Control Plans

The Alaska Dream Center is a men’s residential addiction recovery center located in Palmer on New Hope Street. The Walk of Hope is to raise funds for the building of our family housing project and a women’s center. We will be walking 140 miles from New Hope Street in Palmer to the town of Hope Alaska. This is an eleven day walk, averaging 13 miles per day, starting on May 1st. We will be walking on pedestrian trails when available. There will be no need to stop traffic or close any roads. We will be highly organized placing watch for pedestrian signs W2-11 every two miles each day, wearing reflector vests, walking in up to, 5-10 small groups of, 4-5 individuals in each group single file where necessary, with check point stations at each day’s half way point. Safety rules and training will be stressed from organizational leaders, who will walk at the front, middle and the back of the groups. The trail map highlights our rout. ___ We will bypass areas by bus deemed necessary in our consulting with Shaman Traffic Control.

 Day one Wed. May 1st 13 miles Palmer Fishhook, to Glenn Hwy. to Alaska Street. in Palmer to Glenn Hwy. To Fox Run Campgrounds Glenn Hwy. Approximate arrival 2:00
- Day two Thur. May 2nd 12 miles Starting point Old Glen Hwy pullout to Chugiak Gate Way Fellowship. Bypass Bridges by bus. Arrive 2:00
- Day three Fri. May 3rd 10 miles Leave Gateway, take Glenn Hwy using bike trails, to Kings Way AOG 10336 E. Eagle River AK. Arrive 2:00 pm
- Day four Sat. May 4th 16 miles Leave KWAOG , take Glenn Hwy. to Boniface Parkway, following off street pathway through Russian Jack Springs Park, to off street pathways to Chester Creek trail, ending on, C Street, spending the night at First Assembly of God 1540 C st. Anchorage AK. Arrival time 4:00pm
- Day five Sun. May 5th 8 miles Leaving FAOG at 1:00pm, traveling from C street and Chester creek trail on C Street, ending on Klett Rd. and the Old Seward. Spending the night at South Anchorage AOG 12101 Brayton, Anchorage Ak. Approximate arrival time 4:00pm
- Day six Mon. May 6th 17 miles 10:00am Leaving from Klett Rd, traveling on Old Seward Hwy. to train after Potters Marsh. Bypass narrow part of Seward Hwy. by bus to Indian Valley Bible Church, 102 Seward Hwy. Indian Valley AK. Approximate arrival time 4:00pm
- Day seven Tue. May 7th 14 miles 10:00am leaving Indian Valley traveling on Seward Hwy to Girdwood AK. Arrival 4:00pm
- Day eight Wed. May 8th 12 miles Leaving Girdwood at 10:00am traveling on Seward Hwy, to Alaska Wildlife Conservation on Seward Hwy. Whittier Exit AK. Approximate arrival time 3:00pm
- Day nine Thurs. May 9th 13 miles Leaving AWC at 10:00am traveling on Seward Hwy. to Williwaw Camp Grounds Seward Hwy.
- Day ten Fri. May 10th 13 miles Leaving Williwaw Camp 10:00 am, ½ way point to Hope, bus to Hope Sea Side view Campgrounds
- Day eleven Sat. May 11th 13 miles Leave ½ way point at 10:00am on Seward Hwy, to Hope exit, arrive in Hope 3:00pm, staying at Sea Side View Campgrounds, Hope Alaska
